Petertide ordinations have long been part of the Church's tradition and the feast day of St Peter and St Paul (June 29) is a celebration of the Church's evangelism and mission to be sent out to proclaim the Good News. For the community of Worcester Cathedral the festival has an added layer of joy as we recall the dedication of the first Cathedral on this site to St Peter — a commemoration and celebration which connects us to those early years of Christian witness in the city. The great quire screen, designed by Gilbert Scott, has on it a number of statues reflecting the life of the Cathedral, not least on the east side, flanking the entrance, St Peter and St Paul. These two great saints are also either side of the entrance of the north porch. We who worship today stand in this long line of witness — not just in Worcester but right back to the apostles upon whose witness the Church of God is built.
